



**6 Days/5 Nights**  
**Usambara Mountain Trekking**  
**MAWENI- MZUMBAI TOUR**

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**Day 1: Arusha - Maweni Farm**

Pickup in Arusha and drive to Soni Usambara Mountain with lunch enroute; late afternoon stay at leisure on the farm or wandering in park-like garden around the lake, and beautiful mountain footpaths above through forest and coffee farms. Maweni has an amazing diversity of birds attracted by the water and varied landscape, accommodation at Maweni Farm

**Day 2: GROWING ROCK & Ndelemai forest Reserve Hiking**

1/2 day tour through coffee and tea plantations in Magila to "Growing Rock" and then Ndelemai forest; accommodation at Maweni Farm

**Day 3 & 4: MAZUMBAI RAINFOREST WALKS**

2 days of easy walk through scenic coffee and tea farms to Bumbuli on day one; then on forest paths to Mazumbai on day two. Mazumbai has the last unlogged rainforest in the West Usambara, and is one of the richest forest environments in Africa. Accommodation at Amani Research Station on day 1; Return to Maweni by car on the fourth day for overnight

**Day 5: Drive around Mgwashi and Nkongoi villages**

Drive around Mgwashi and Nkongoi villages view other side of the mountain visit several Sambaa traditional healers before driving back to Maweni. Accommodation and diner in Maweni Farm

**Day 6: Drive to Dar es Salaam/Arusha**

Early morning start driving back to Dar es Salaam with buffet Breakfast in Korogwe; direct to the

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF USAMBARA HIKING**

Hiking in Usambara is done by trekking from village to village following local paths and roads which pass through farmland, forests and over mountain peaks. Each evening you will arrive in a small village and stay at a local guesthouse/rest house. It is easy to find new routes through the vast network of scenic footpaths that cross the mountains, and there are thousands of places to explore along the

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way. Villagers have remained curious and very hospitable. This is the land of greens full of vegetable and fresh fruits

**GUIDES:** Are well-trained and knowledgeable to the environment and culture of Usambara (Wa Sambia). Part of the guiding & hiking fees go to the village development fund which is greatly appreciated by villagers in the area
